COMMITTEE RECOMMENDATION

1. That the Pittwater Public Space and Recreation Strategy, as amended and referred to in Section 4.2 of this Report, and the relevant recommendations referred to in pages 87 to 100 of the Strategy, be adopted.
2. That the recommendations contained in the Strategy be considered when Council's delivery plans are being compiled.
3. That Recommendation 7.1.1 be amended by the addition of a further point:
That Council staff continue to work with the Aboriginal Heritage Office (AHO) to determine appropriate sites to place signage that reflects authenticated Pittwater Aboriginal history.
4. That the Introduction on Page 12 have inserted a further paragraph to read:
That Pittwater Council recognises and acknowledges the traditional owners of the land on which this strategy is located.
5. That the following amendment be made to the second paragraph on page 218:
That this land be considered more suitable for sportsfields than residential development due to flooding risks.
